CHRISTMAS IN JULY 2014

KNITTING CLASSES

RUG HOOKING WITH YARN: Learn to rug hook an ornament using yarn. In the first class, students learn to pull up loops of yarn through the backing material. Students will be able to finish hooking the project at home. At the second class, students will learn to find the edge of the project and finish the back of the ornament. CHRISTMAS PICKLE: The tradition of the blown glass Christmas pickle ornament began many years ago in Germany and inspired this quilt, designed by Lynda Milligan and Nancy Smith of Possibilities. This beautiful design lends itself to many different fabric combinations and even though the pattern name is seasonal, you will want to display your quilt all year long. You will learn 3 different techniques in this class: Paper pieced pickle rings, pieced curves, and a couple of different techniques for making pinwheels. (\$55.00) 5 hours – **Lynda Milligan**

CHRISTMAS STOCKING: Learn the basics of making a lined Christmas stocking with a cuff. Various materials and embellishments will be discussed. Jane will provide the pattern for this fun workshop! Bring along orphan blocks if you want – and incorporate them into a cool, "quilty" stocking! (\$17.00) 2 ½ hours – **Jane Dumler**

CHRISTMAS TREE SKIRT: Such a fun and easy pattern that looks impressive, too! It is available in two sizes. Although this very cool tree skirt looks difficult, it goes together quickly! Make it reversible by using a contrasting or coordinating backing. 6 hours (\$40.00) – **Peggy Supplee**

COME QUILT WITH ME! No pattern required, just the willingness to quilt, share and enjoy fellowship with like-minded quilters. Jessica will be on hand to help you with those pesky UFOs. You won't want to miss this fun group! Bring a snack to share! (\$20.00) 5 hours – **Jessica Vaughn**

HOLIDAY RAINFOREST PLACEMATS AND/OR TABLE RUNNER: This great pattern is fun and makes a special focus fabric really stand out! You'll learn easy ways to get beautiful results with the interlocking rings in the pattern (see the photo on the website) Placemats on July 8th and we will be using the same pattern for the Holiday Table Runner Class on Sunday, July 27th, so join both classes - or take either one and you will have all the tools you need to make a special table setting for your holiday guests.... Of course, you could make the placemats in a non-holiday fun fabric for everyday! 4 hours (\$30.00) **Peggy Supplee**

LONE STAR QUILT: This traditional quilt may be done in a formal or scrap setting. We'll cover two methods of piecing in class. * Foundation piecing using the QuiltSmart Interfacing for a star that finishes at 58" Square. This may be expanded with borders of your choice to make a larger quilt. OR * Strip Method to complete a star ranging in size from 42" square to 75" square. These quilts will finish in a range of 50 x 50 to 100 x 100 – depending on your chosen borders. 6 hours (\$40.00) **Jane Dumler**

BASIC ZENTANGLE@: A Fun & Easy Art Form: Simply amaze yourself with your own hidden talent, even if you think you can't draw a straight line! Zentangle@ is a fun and easy drawing technique that everyone can learn - as you make beautiful abstract pictures. Using only six easy marks (comma, dot, circle, straight line and curved lines) you can make simple patterns called "tangles" to combine in many creative ways. In class, learn more than 8 "tangles" and complete at least two drawings. Take home the skills and supplies to make many more. This drawing technique is so absorbing that many forget there are others in the room. Great for those who are curious about learning a freeing, creative, meditative art form. 3 hours (\$35.00) + \$10 materials kit fee payable on the day of class - **Dusty Darrah**
